Contemporary Church - the centrality of Vatican 11; Lumen Gentium; Mystery, Communio, People of God; Authority; Priesthood of all; Role of the Laity

7. Sacramental Life of the Church

The sacramental nature of human life; Foundations for sacramental theology in the Paschal Mystery; Sacraments of Initiation; other sacraments

Liturgical Life of the Church

Reflecting on the nature of Catholic liturgy as the 'primary and indispensable source of the true Christian spirit'. (CSL a. 14)
